The Safeguarding Champion of Sport Resolutions (UK) will be elected from the Board at each Annual General Meeting. They can be a Representative or Independent Non-Executive Director.

Term: one year, appointed at each Annual General Meeting

### **Responsibilities**

To ensure that Safeguarding is included as an agenda item at Board meetings whenever appropriate

To ensure that the Board takes safeguarding issues into consideration when making decisions

To present to the Board, on an annual basis, statistical and qualitative equality information

To work with the Lead Safeguarding Officer and/or Deputy Safeguarding Officer on the 'Safeguarding Standard for Sport'

To contribute to and to approve the Safeguarding Action Plan

To be available as a member of the pool of Directors for the Complaints/Grievance, Disciplinary and Appeals processes

To help ensure that all employees receive up to date training on Safeguarding
